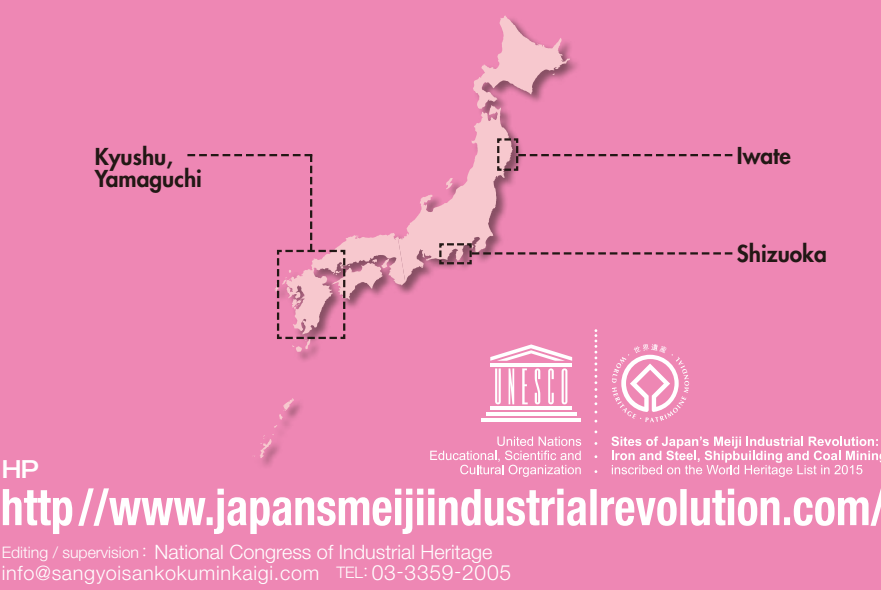

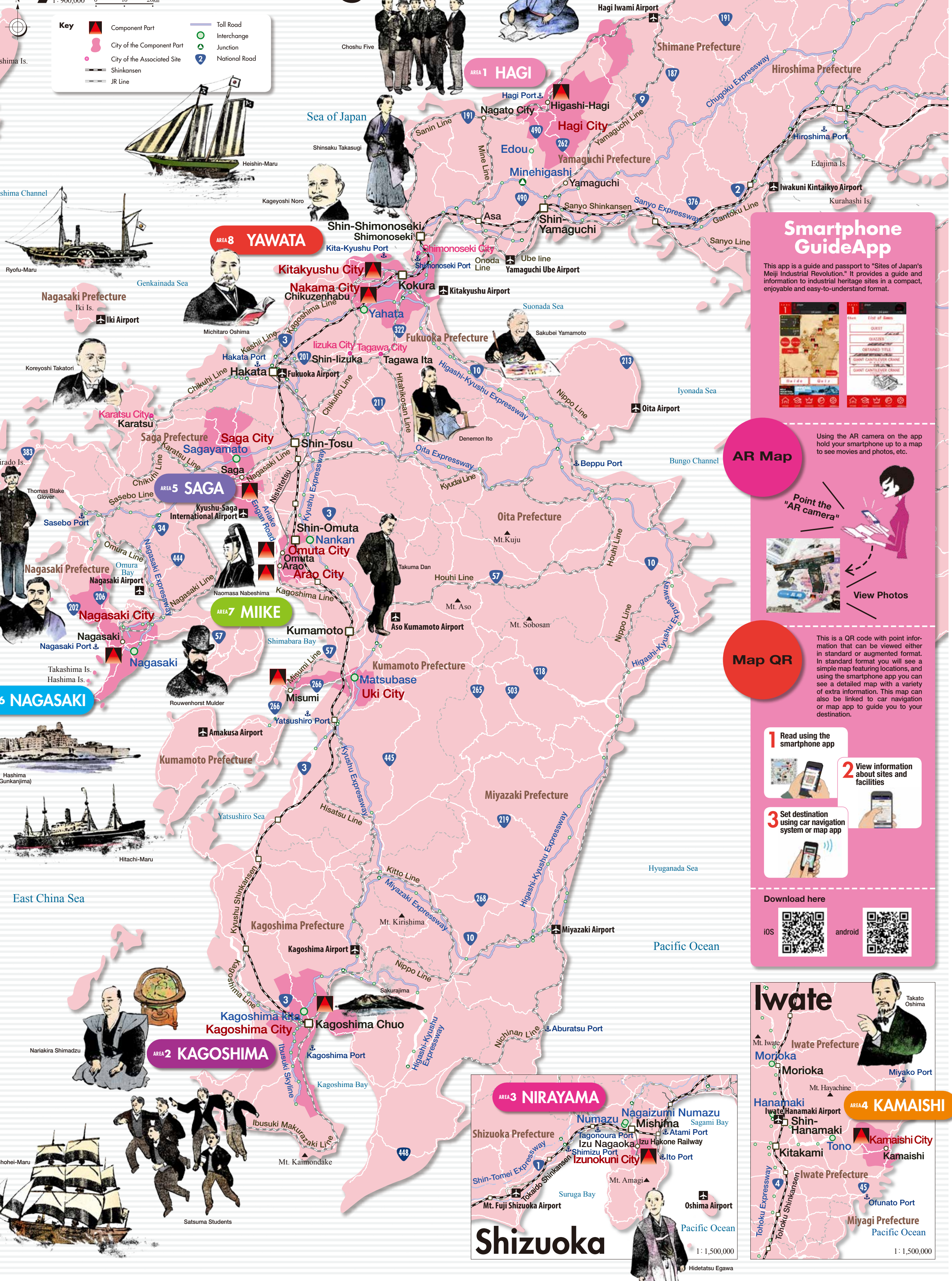

Smartphone GuideApp

This app is a guide and passport to "Sites of Japan's Meiji Industrial Revolution." It provides a guide and information to industrial heritage sites in a compact, enjoyable and easy-to-understand format.



AR Map
